A: Introduction:

The National Units for Mine Action and Development is considered as one of the leading organizations in the field of mine and unexploded ordnance clearance, and awareness of mines and remnants of war risk, It has a clear mission, vision, and goals aimed at achieving its achievements in the field of voluntary and humanitarian work.

The organization was able to achieve many of these milestones that contribute to establishing the foundations of stability, peace and societal security.

The celebration of International Day for Mine Awareness and Assistance this year was exceptional due to the war conditions taking place in the country, which prevented the celebration from being held in the usual manner annually. This year's celebration came in the form of awareness campaigns in all of the organization's sub_ offices in South Kordofan State, Blue Nile Region, North Darfur, Kassala State and Khartoum State - Omdurman in both the Karari and Old Omdurman localities, which had the largest share in celebrating by launch the project to clear and raise awareness of remnants of war in cooperation with Mine Action Center in both of Karari and old Omdurman localities, by forming two RRT emergency teams for rapid response and intervention to clear remnants of war danger , to achieve the safety of lives and supporting the stability of citizens.

2. Ensuring the safety of society from the danger of mines and war remnants.
3. Reflecting the organization's achievements and the efforts made in the field of combating mines, especially during the war period.

B:Head Quarter:

National Units Head Quarter celebration was represented by the Director-GeneralThe presidential celebration was represented by the Director-General's speech, which was broadcast on the media and social networking sites, in which he sent greetings to all segments of society and stressed the organization's keenness to advocate the issue of mines and Unexploded Remnants of War and make it a public issue.

The day included providing awareness lectures to shelter centers in Damazin at (Al-Shuhadaa, Rabat) schools, theatrical performances and a lecture competition for (50) families, equivalent to (250) children, (120) children and (130) men and women.

Under the slogan of “protecting lives and supporting stability”, the National Units for Mine Action and Development Organization held a celebration of the International Day for Mine Awareness and Assistance on April 4, 2024, in both, alsalam Shelter Center and Martyr Baldo Shelter Center in Kassala state.

Honored by National Mine Action Center Director, Humanitarian Aid commissioner, the head of security affairs in the state, and the Chairman and members of the committee organizing the displaced in the shelter centers in kassala state.

National Units for Mine Action and Development Organization director in Kassala spoke, explaining the organization’s pioneering role in providing awareness lectures on remnants of war and unexploded ordnance, he stressed all segments of society to be careful and not to lift or move any foreign object and to immediately report it to the competent authorities, explaining the numbers that belong to the organization and which can be contacted, In the event that foreign objects are found, he also highlighted the role that organization played recently at all Sudan states, in clearance unexploded ordnance remnants of war, in coordination with the National Mine Action Center, In the same context, awareness lectures on remnants of war were presented, a number of posters with awareness messages about remnants of war and unexploded ordnance were also distributed.

The number of beneficiaries of Men (23) and Women (42) and Children (boy (203) and girl (177)) the celebration found widespread support from the state’s community and its localities, they expressed their thanks and gratitude by delivering awareness messages to the affected communities.

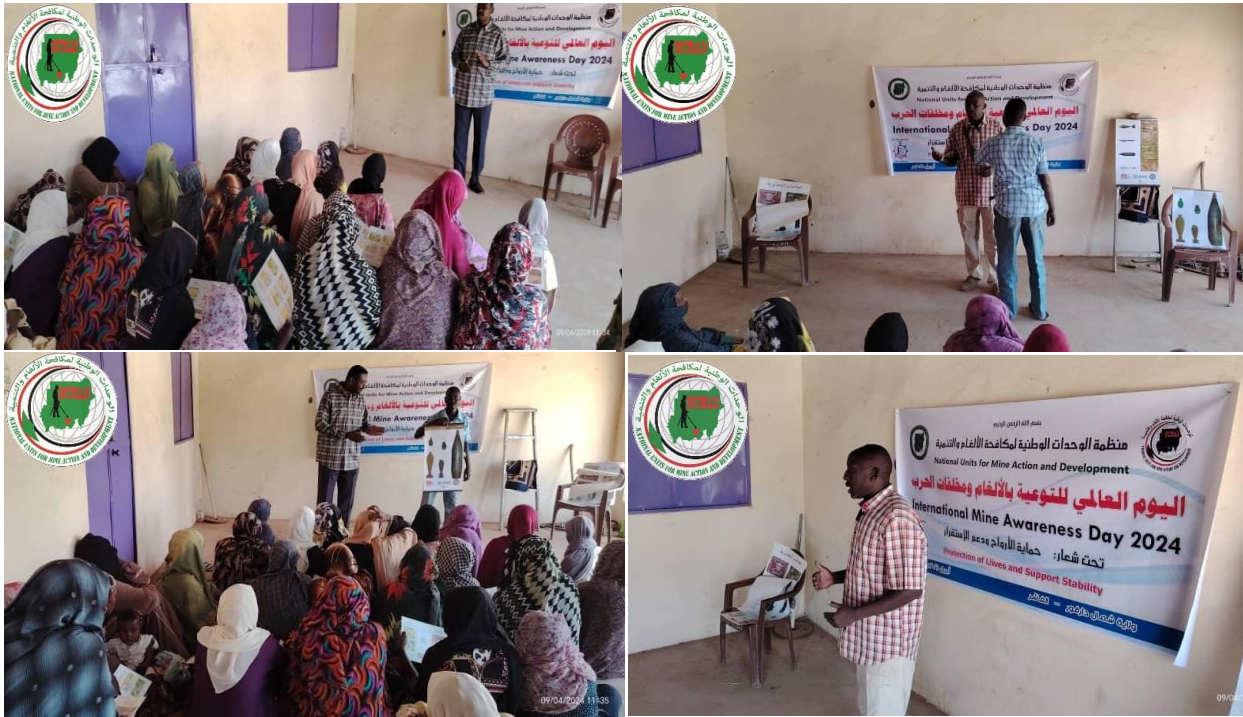
